




What is GoForth CarShare?

Opportunity to learn about and experience EVs. This
project will demonstrate and refine a model to provide
EVs and charging stations to rural communities,
benefiting local residents while raising awareness about
non-traditional transportation approaches.



- Affordable carsharing for communities. Rent an EV for \$4/hour.
- Funded primarily through Washington State Department of Transportation
 Zero-Emissions Access Program Grant, with additional funding from the Bonneville
 Environmental Foundation.
- Partnering with the Cities of Bingen and White Salmon, Mobility Development,
 OpConnect, Washington Gorge Action Program, and other local community organizations.



- You can view GoForth CarShare locations and other carsharing networks in the Miocar app.




Pricing


- First drive free!
- \$4/hour or \$35/day
- 150 miles included, 35 cents/mile for each additional mile driven
- Price includes insurance, roadside assistance, maintenance, 24/7 member support, unlimited charging of the carshare vehicle at its home charging station (members may charge elsewhere at their own expense)

 - Vehicle/trip-related issues only






Driving an EV


- All GoForth vehicles seat five people. You may drive up to four other people in the car during your trip, but you are the only person who can drive the car.
- 100% electric with about 150-250 miles of range depending on model of car.
- To check range: dashboard will show maximum, minimum and median range est.
- You are responsible for keeping battery charge level above 20% during your trip.
- We are happy to help you plan your trips around your charging needs.










- Book up to 24 hours at a time
- You will get charged for the full time booked
- Cancel up to two hours before your trip with no penalty
- Extend a trip in the Miocar app
- Always return the car to its home charging station on time


Starting Your Trip

- 1. Inspect the car for any issues or damage.
- 2. Unlock the car to start your trip. Only use the Miocar app to unlock and lock the car. Do not use a physical key fob or the physical lock buttons on the car.
- 3. The immobilizer and anti-theft lock are security features to prevent the car from being stolen. To avoid triggering these features:
 - a. Do not use a key fob.
 - b. Do not use the lock buttons on the car.
 - c. Do not lock the car through the app while you still have a door open or while you are inside the car.
- 4. If the app is ever not working, please call our customer support line.
- 5. Vehicle Access Cards are available and can be used interchangeable with the Miocar app to unlock and lock the car.



Ending Your Trip

- 1. Make sure EV is plugged in and charging
 - Take the charging card from the center console
 - Scan the charging card on the charging station
 - Plug the charger cord into the car's port
 - Return charging card to center console
- 2. Prepare to leave the car
 - Remove all belongings and close all vehicle doors
 - Use sanitizing wipes on high touch surfaces
- 3. Open Miocar app and end trip



Reminders

- No smoking in car
- Pets must be transported inside a carrier, cage, or kennel
